We're very pleased that after completing high school, six of our young women have elected to pursue a career in Early Childhood Education, teaching children in Nursery School through 3rd grade.

Each of our girls, while doing her student teaching, was asked by her school administration to stay on as a paid employee. They're taking evening classes to complete their studies while teaching during the day. They exemplify the kind of young adults we aspire to develop through this ministry.

The St. Nicholas Uganda Children's Fund supports over 240 orphans and vulnerable children in primary & secondary school, vocational & professional training, and university.
