Secondary school in Uganda consists of two Levels: O (Ordinary) and A (Advanced). A Level is academically rigorous, comparable to Junior College in the U.S. This year we had six students complete their A Level education with all six qualifying for university admission. (See photo below.) Four students will be attending Ndejje University: Jovia and Leticia in Accounting & Finance, and Angella and Zaitun in Information Technology. Two students will be attending Nkumba University: Ashiraf in Business Administration and Aisha in Journalism & Public Relations.

Graduates

Because of the COVID disruption, we will have two academic years of university students graduating later this year, a total of eleven students. Our Nkumba University graduates will receive degrees in Business Administration, Tourism, Social Work, and Journalism. Lydia will graduate from Ndejje University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Survey Engineering.
