At the end of each academic year (October-December), Ugandan students in Primary 7, Senior 4, and Senior 6 sit for national exams. The results of these standardized assessments indicate the students' capacity for success at their next level of education, and also determine which path is appropriate based on their aptitude and interest. For example: further academic studies vs. vocational training, or university vs. business college. As we've stated before, children are accepted into our program based on need, not academic potential. Therefore, it is gratifying when we see that they

have performed well. To date, we have received results for the P.7 and S.4 classes, and are waiting for the S.6 results. Students who pass are grouped into four divisions, with Division One being the best. Last year, we had eleven primary students sit for the exams. Two ranked in Division One, and seven in Division Two. Our top student, Peter, not only had the best results in his school, but he was best in the entire testing center. Of our thirteen students in S.4, eight ranked in Division One, and three in Division Two. Our top student, Esther, earned Distinctions in nine of the ten subjects. Advancing to A Level secondary (Senior 5 & 6), students specialize in a combination of subjects that lead to a particular vocation. Six of our eight Div. I students are doing pre-medicine, and two are doing pre-engineering, including Esther. Another one of our girls will be going directly to nursing school. Their performance is a testimony to hard work and their desire to succeed, and is made possible by your prayers and financial support. Thank you.
